

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING JANUARY 10, 2012
OF THE MT. LEBANON COMMISSION**

The Commission of Mt. Lebanon, Pennsylvania, held a Regular Meeting at 8:00 P.M., on Tuesday, January 10, 2012, at the Municipal Building, 710 Washington Road. President Brumfield called the meeting to order and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Manager Stephen M. Feller called the roll. Present were Commissioners John Bendel, Kelly Fraasch, Matt Kluck, Kristen Linfante, and Dave Brumfield. Also present were Manager Feller, Assistant Manager Taylor, Chief of Police McDonough, Recreation Director Donnellan, Public Works Director Kelley, Fire Chief Sohyda, Planning Officer McGill, and Information Officer Jantz. Also present were Phil Weis of the solicitor's office and Dan Deiseroth of the engineer's office.

CITIZEN COMMENTS

Bill Lewis of 816 Ridgefield Drive spoke in support of establishing a school board liaison as well as joint meetings occasionally between the commission and school board. He also spoke in support of the parking facilities committee. He added that there is still a link on the municipal website for the parking authority website. He asked that the plaque on the outside of the former parking authority building be removed and given to the historic society. He also inquired about the high school construction project and traffic issues. Mr. Feller stated that a preconstruction meeting was held today between the school and municipality, and they are in the process of working out the details.

Ms. Linfante informed Mr. Lewis that she is the liaison for the parking committee, and she looks forward to working with him. She stated that she supports the school project, and she agrees that a liaison would be the first step in moving toward joint meetings.

Elaine Gillen of 735 Vallevista Avenue stated that she watched the school board meeting, and it was stated that they wish to work with the municipality to establish public joint steering committee meetings. She suggested the municipality thoroughly study the traffic patterns before the high school project construction begins.

Chuck Satterfield of 1015 Martha Avenue asked that repairs be made to Martha Avenue, which is a brick, dead-end street.

David Huston of 505 Sleepy Hollow Road spoke about the storm sewer invoice he received, stating that it's to be returned to McMurray, PA. He asked that a process be established whereby residents may drop the payment off at the municipal building. He also suggested placing the previous balance on the storm sewer invoices.

Dave Egler of 121 Poplar Drive stated that part of Pennsylvania Boulevard, which is brick, needs reconstructed.

Dave Barkley of 249 Hazel Drive inquired as to why the post office is not delivering the magazine anymore. Mr. Feller stated that the post office is supposed to deliver the magazine, but they are not consistent in delivering the magazine to residents in the 15228 and 15216 zip code areas. He added that the municipality has filed numerous complaints with the post office and is attempting to have the problem corrected.

REPORT BY JUNIOR COMMISSIONER BILL POSTUFKA

Bill Postufka stated that he is a senior at Mt. Lebanon high school, and he was excited to start this new position and looked forward to working with the Commission and staff.
