

MT. LEBANON TRAFFIC BOARD

Meeting Date: May 6, 2015

Ms. Brown opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1 – Roll call was taken. Mr. Setcavage was absent.

Agenda Item 2 - Minutes of the April 1, 2015 Traffic Board Meeting.

Motion was made to approve the minutes of the April 1, 2015 meeting. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 4 – Request for Signage in 1300 Block of Washington Road

Mr. Brown stated that Speakman Alley is a private road and the municipality is not responsible for signage for this roadway. He advised that residents submit their request to PennDot. No one was in attendance to speak on this matter. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 5 – Neighborhood Traffic Management, N. Meadowcroft Ave and Sleepy Hollow Road

Mr. Brown stated that data has been collected on both N. Meadowcroft and Sleepy Hollow Road. Neighborhood meetings will be arranged and scheduled for the end of May or beginning of June with Ward Commissioners and residents to hear the recommended options for these areas.

Agenda Item 6 - Request for Public Safety Permit Parking on Shady Drive East

Lt. Fisher stated during the hotel construction on Washington Road, the workers parked on Shady Drive East near the entrance to the Public Safety Building parking lot. He stated there were no issues as far as accidents or complaints during this time. He suggested that these spaces be marked for Public Safety Permit Parking Only for over flow parking at the Public Safety Center during times when volunteer firefighters are called in and/or training days. Mr. Brown stated that the center yellow lines could be moved to widen the west bound lane. Mr. Brown will conduct a study to assure there would be enough room for the Port Authority busses to navigate the bend if the lane were widened. There will be a follow up on this item at the June meeting.

Agenda Item 12 - Items from the Floor

Ms. McNulty, Newburn Drive requested that a follow up study be done on Newburn Drive. She stated she does not feel that traffic has slowed since the speed humps were installed. Board members advised that a follow up study was completed and requested Lt. Fisher coordinate with Ms. McNulty regarding the results. If there were further questions she will be placed on the agenda for June.

There were no additional items. Meeting adjourned at 7:25 pm.
