

MT. LEBANON TRAFFIC BOARD

Meeting Date: September 2, 2015

Mr. Cooley opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1: Roll Call. Mr. Setcavage, Ms. Brown and Mr. Fitzgerald were absent.

Agenda Item 2: Meeting Notes from August 5, 2015

Motion was made to approve the minutes. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 3: Opening Remarks from the Chair

Agenda Item 4: Request for No Parking Signs on Newburn Drive Near Intersection with Beverly Road

Mr. Haberman stated that the Municipal Ordinance states that a vehicle shall not Park a vehicle within 30 feet of a stop sign. At this intersection there is approximately 56 feet along the west side of Newburn where parking is permitted, making it possible for 2 vehicles to pass safely. Lt. Fisher stated that the curbs on the island at this intersection are painted yellow but there are no signs prohibiting parking and the painted curbs are not enforceable. He suggested installing No Parking signs on the island. He advised he will submit a request to Municipal Manger Feller for the installation of No Parking Signs on the east side of Newburn on the island. No further action taken.

Agenda Item 5: Items from the Floor

Ms. Joy Pajak, 730 Crystal Drive spoke regarding the safety of students walking to Howe School in the area of Crystal Drive and Gypsy Lane, she suggested a crosswalk be installed at this intersection along with additional school zone signage. Ms. Pajak was advised that this request will be placed on the October agenda.

Ms. Eileen Sharbaugh, 207 Birch Avenue stated that her daughter was involved in an accident on Route 19 while making a left turn out of Dunkin Donuts parking lot. She asked if the left hand turn could be eliminated. Mr. Haberman stated that is a private driveway and the permits were issued by PennDot. Lt. Fisher suggested Ms. Sharbaugh submit a request to PennDot through the their website.

Mr. Scott Zasadil, 126 Academy Avenue stated that vehicles frequently parking blocking the entrance to his driveway. He asked if there was an ordinance restricting him from painting the curb in front of his residence. Lt. Fisher advised there was not.

Mr. Keith McGill, Municipal Planner introduced himself to the Board, stating that effective October 16, 2015 he will be interim Manager and he is available to the Board for any concerns or questions. He also spoke regarding the driveway at Dunkin Donuts, stating that since the building was an existing building they were not required to make changes to the roadway. He advised that contacting PennDot through their website was the best option.
