**Parks Advisory Board Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, November 3rd, 2015 - 8:00 p.m.
Municipal Building Room C**

I. Call to Order and Roll Call

Ms. Zadecky called the meeting to order, and proceeded with the Roll Call. The meeting was attended by Board Members Ron Block, Eliane Kramer, Carrie Beck, Jonathan Farrell, Pam Burrett, and Megan Zadecky

The meeting was also attended by Commissioner Steve Silverman, the Director of Public Works Rudy Sukal, and Facilities & Parks Coordinator Phillip Avolio.

Hugh Beal was absent.

II. Citizens Comments

III. Approval of October 6, 2015 Meeting Minutes

A motion was made by Ms. Zadecky and a second by Ms. Kramer to accept the minutes as submitted. The motion was passed and the minutes were accepted.

IV. Welcoming of New Member

Ms. Zadecky introduced new member Pam Burrett to the Parks Advisory Board.

V. Facility and Parks Coordinator

Mr. Sukal introduced the new Facilities & Parks Coordinator, Phillip Avolio to the Parks Advisory Board. Mr. Avolio will be attending future meetings.

VI. PAB Capital Improvement Recommendations

Mr. Silverman presented the Board with their prioritized list of Capital Improvement Recommendations, asking the group to re-visit the list for any changes in priority.

A motion was made by Ms. Zadecky to accept the listing order of the PAB Capital Improvement Recommendations. A second motion was made by Mr. Farrell and the listing was accepted.

VII. Deer in the Parks

Mr. Silverman reported that disagreements still exist between Mt. Lebanon and Scott Township on the use of Twin Hills Park for Archery Hunting. He also reported that there are currently 18 private property groups allowing the contractor to engage in archery hunting on their property. The locations are unknown.

VIII. New Business

Mr. Block reported on the current Scout Projects. In Bird Park, rain diverters and the re-working of sections of trails have been completed. Another group has also installed 200' of gravel and 500' of bark mulch to the park's trails, while a footbridge was also installed. Scouts have also continued to work on clearing invasives from a three quarter to one acre section of the park. Mr. Block would like to thank Mr. Sukal and the Public Works Department for their fast response to material needs and cleanup.

IX. Announcements

Mr. Farrell announced that there will be a group working this weekend from 10:00am-3:00pm in Bird Park, planting a mixed variety of trees.

Mr. Sukal stated that he will have the crew leave fencing and stakes outside the Public Works Garage for the group to use.
