Agenda Item 4: Request for Change of Traffic Pattern on Ordale Blvd. at Washington Road Intersection

Lt. Rayburg stated that he received a request to look at the traffic patterns in the vicinity of Ordale and surrounding areas of Route 19 due to illegal left turns and illegal U-turns at Ordale Blvd. He reported that he observed the area over the previous two days and did not observe any violations. He suggested that the complaint was made due to the heavy holiday traffic in the area of the Galleria Mall. There was no one in attendance to discuss specifics on this request. Board members recommended increased enforcement in the area and tabled the issue pending any new complaints.
