

Community Relations Board (CRB) Minutes

REPORTS:

Chair:

Lisa Borrelli Dorn suggested that the board invite new Assistant Manager/Planner Ian McMeans to a future meeting. All agreed that was a good idea.

Commission Liaison:

Commissioner Steve Silverman reported that plans have been proposed for a dog park but there still are significant problems that need to be addressed.

Steve gave an overview on some financial issues, as the budget process is soon to begin:

—The ice rink's 40-year-old plumbing and ice-making systems need replacing at a cost of \$1.5 million.

—The public works yard needs significant upgrades to provide for adequate storage and maintenance.

—The Commission is looking at the possibility of upgrading the pistol range. There is a discussion about whether it would be possible to coordinate with the high school and install a rifle range that could be used by the student rifle team, as well as for police and community training programs.
