

MT. LEBANON TRAFFIC BOARD

Meeting Date: June 1, 2016

Ms. Brown opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1: Roll Call. Mr. Setcavage was absent.

Agenda Item 2: Meeting Notes from May 4, 2016

Motion was made to approve the minutes. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 3: Opening Remarks from the Chair

Follow up Items:

Agenda Item 4: Request to Move Stop Sign on Sweet Gum at Intersection with Pinoak

Mr. Haberman reviewed the conditions at this intersection along with other possible locations to relocate the stop sign. He stated that based on his review the stop sign is in an appropriate location and did not recommend moving it.

Ms. Jean Thomas, 737 Pinaok Road spoke in regards to other options. Mr. Fitzgerald suggested painting a stop bar at the intersection.

Motion was made to install/paint a stop bar on Sweet Gum at the intersection with Pinoak. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 5: Request to Move No Parking Sign on Pinaok Near the Intersection with Ruth

Mr. Haberman stated that drivers turning left onto Pinoak Road from Ruth Street are unable to see the two No Parking signs that are currently on Pinoak. He recommended an additional No Parking sign be added to the north side of Pinaok Road west of the intersection with Ruth Street.

Lt. Rayburg stated he would request the Public Works Department install this additional sign. Board members asked if residents in the vicinity of the new signage needed to be notified prior to the installation. Lt. Rayburg will discuss this with Municipal Manager McGill and report back at the September meeting. This item will be placed on the September agenda for follow up.

Agenda Item 6: Discussion on Overnight Parking Restrictions / Ordinance

Item was tabled.

Agenda Item 7: Request for Removal of NO Left Turn sign on Ruth Street

No one was present to discuss this request. This item was voted on at the May meeting. Board members agreed that an item should not be revisited once it has been voted on. No further action taken.

Agenda Item 8: Discussion on Go-Zone

No action was taken on this item. Board members requested more guidance from Commissioners on the scope of this review. Commissioner Fraasch was not in attendance and board members did not receive any further information from her.

New Items:

Agenda Item 9: Request to Review Traffic and Parking on Roselawn and Central Square

No one was present to discuss this request. No action taken.

Agenda Item 10: Items from the Floor

Mr. Michael Horner, 1502 Worcester Drive spoke regarding the current construction on Painters Run Road and the increase in cut through traffic due to the road closure. He suggested putting speed humps on Worcester. Board members explained the process for requesting speed humps. Mr. Horner suggested that these issues should be anticipated and dealt with prior to roads being closed.

Mr. Shawn Haltman, 247 Gilkeson Road stated that he made the request to the board to keep the mid-block crosswalk on Gilkeson Road. Mr. Haberman stated that PennDot denied the request and recommended pedestrians be directed to the intersection at Cedar Blvd. and the light at the Galleria to cross.
