

## MT. LEBANON TRAFFIC BOARD

Meeting Date: February 1, 2017

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Mr. Fitzgerald opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1: Roll Call, new board member Mr. Glock was absent.

Agenda Item 2: Meeting Notes from January 4, 2017.

Motion was made to approve the minutes. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 3: Opening Remarks from the Chair

Old Business:

Agenda Item 4: Request for Traffic Calming in the 800 Block of Country Club Drive

Mr. Haberman reported that the signage in the area of the curve on Country Club Drive are outdated and do not meet the new retro-reflectivity standards and are located 250 feet in advance of the curve.

Ms. Melisa Moorehead, 811 Country Club Drive, questioned why the initial data exceeded the volume threshold and the new data did not. She spoke regarding her concern for the safety of the children walking to school.

Lt. Rayburg stated that the initial data was collected using the Sentry, due to the high volume data it was recommended to conduct a second study using the ATR which is more accurate.

A motion was made to install recommended pavement markings and updated signage within 100 feet of the horizontal curve on Country Club Drive and install crosswalks on the east bound Audubon Avenue approach to Country Club Drive. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 5: Request for Mid-Block Crosswalk on Old Hickory Road at Pedestrian Steps to Moffett Street

Mr. Jeff Wetzal, 881 Old Hickory Road requested that parking restrictions be kept at 50 feet from proposed crosswalk.

A resident stated he had no issues with the crosswalk but requested that parking restrictions be kept at 50 feet from crosswalk. He also stated that the speed and volume are the bigger issue in this area.

Mr. Jonathan Golli spoke in support of the crosswalk and keeping the restrictions to 50 feet of the crosswalk.

Lt. Rayburg advised that once the crosswalk is installed the Traffic Sentry will be temporarily put in place advising drivers of the crosswalk.

A motion was made to install a crosswalk on Old Hickory Road at the pedestrian steps to Moffett Street and install parking restrictions within 50 feet of the crosswalk. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
