

## South Hills Recycling Competition


### Status of Municipal Recycling Competition as of March 24, 2011:

The below summary charts and graphs represent the residential recycling statistics for the two month period ending February 28, 2011. Mt. Lebanon is leading in the most tons above base year category with 93.82 tons above 2010; South Park is ahead in the percentage above base year category with 168% above base year, and Mt. Lebanon with 402.28 tons is out front in the most tons collected rankings. This is only the second month of the competition and the lead in all categories will change several times before year's end. Donations totaling \$2,000.00 have been received from the PNC Corporation, Waste Management of Pittsburgh, Allied Waste and GreenStar Recycling. These funds will be used to promote the competition.

Graph 2 Most Tonnage above (Their) Previous Base Year Category



Graph 3 Percentage Above (Their) Previous Year Category


