



## RESIDENT NOTIFICATION

Dear Residents:

Jet Jack, Inc. will be performing Cured in Place trenchless lining of sanitary sewers within the vicinity of your property under contract with the Municipality of Mt. Lebanon. The CIPP work will be performed from approximately 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

There will be no interruption to water service. However, **during installation the sewer service lateral connection to your property will be closed off at the main sewer line.** (After installation all active lateral connections will be reinstated.) **During the CIPP installation it is important that residents use water for emergencies only in order to avoid a backup of the lateral connection of their property.** All sump pumps must be turned off as well. During installation if a resin-like odor is noticed inside the home, this indicates that there are deficient fixture traps and/or whole house traps. Filling basement traps with water may help to prevent this odor from entering the home. Should resin odor enter the home, the house should be ventilated by opening windows and running fans. It is recommended that deficient home plumbing be repaired to include proper functioning house traps and plumbing fixture traps as required by the International Building Code.
