

2017 MUNICIPALITY OF MT. LEBANON

COLLECTION REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

1. **REGULAR CURBSIDE COLLECTION:** Garbage and refuse will be collected once every week according to the street listing on the reverse. Garbage and refuse should be placed at the curb after 6 p.m. on the prior day or **before 6 a.m.** on the scheduled collection day.
2. **GUIDELINES FOR COLLECTION:**
 - Garbage should be properly secured in containers (40 gallons or less) or plastic bags, weighing 50 pounds or less. They should be placed on one area at curbside and should **not exceed 15 bags/cans and 2 bulk items per week.**
 - Grass clippings and weeds should be in plastic bags.
 - Furniture items, appliances, household goods and disassembled children's swing sets will be accepted at curbside.
 - Carpet should be rolled and tied in lengths not to exceed 48 inches so that one man can lift.
 - Empty paint cans and dried paint is acceptable. Paint can be dried by air drying or soaking up with newspaper or kitty litter. Lids should be left off.
3. **EXCLUDED ITEMS:**
 - Building material may be picked up for a **fee** by contacting Republic Services at 800-464-2120.
 - Hazardous Household Waste (including paint, thinners, cleaners, pesticides/herbicides, etc.) - see municipal website for county events (www.prc.org).
 - Automobile parts including wheel rims and tires.
 - **Trees, branches and bushes (see community recycling events page for curbside and drop-off events).**
 - Ashes from furnaces and fireplaces. Stones and dirt.
 - Leaves (municipality provides leaf pickup - see flyer put out in the fall).
 - Electronics per Municipal Ordinance 3184 (see community recycling events page for drop-off events).
4. **SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING:** Recyclables should be placed loose and combined in containers marked with the green "Mt. Lebanon Recycling" sticker. (Additional or new stickers may be picked up at the Mt. Lebanon Municipal Building or Mt. Lebanon Library.)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE: Styrofoam, ceramics, used aluminum foil, food waste, bathroom trash, paper towels, coat hangers, laminated paper, toothpaste tubes, vinyl, plastic straws, Pyrex, plate glass, light bulbs and plastic bags (bags recycled at grocery stores).

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

 - Metal: Metal food cans, steel/bi-metal containers, empty aerosol cans, clean aluminum foil and foil products, beer and soft drink cans.
 - Plastic (codes 1-7 - no Styrofoam): take-out containers, baby wipe containers, empty CD cases, bleach/household cleaner bottles, yogurt cups, cottage cheese, margarine tubs, and shampoo bottles.
 - Glass: bottles and food jars (clear, brown, amber and green).
 - Paper: paperboard (frozen food box, cereal, tissue, shoes, etc.), books (hard covers removed), white office paper, computer paper, newspapers, advertising inserts, cardboard egg carton, *non-soiled pizza box*, junk mail (including envelopes), catalogs, magazines, phone books, coupons and receipts, and paper shopping bags (handles removed), shredded paper (put in translucent bag), corrugated boxes (cut no longer than 36" x 36" and must be tied or bundled.)

Recyclables will be picked up every other week on your regular garbage pickup day. The municipality will be divided into two sections, (A) and (B). Please refer to the street listing attached to be sure when service will be provided and refer to the calendar.
5. **SPECIAL BACKYARD SERVICE (FEE):** Republic Services can furnish backyard collection service limited to four cans of general household refuse plus one recycling container. Grass clippings, furniture and appliances, will be picked up at the curb only. Residents may request this service directly by contacting Republic Services at 800-464-2120. The monthly fee is \$20 for garbage, \$5 for recycle or \$25 for both.
6. **HOLIDAY SERVICE:** If a holiday falls on a Monday through Friday, pickup for the rest of the week will be one day later than the usual day. Observed holidays (boxed on calendar) are: **New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.** If the holiday should fall on a weekend, your pick up day will not be affected.
7. **APPLIANCES CONTAINING REFRIGERANT:** The contractor will collect such items as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers, etc.; however, the item must have a sticker certifying that the refrigerant has been removed. If it does not have the sticker, it will not be picked up. It is unlawful for the contractor to dispose of these items containing refrigerant. For a list of companies that remove refrigerant, please call the Public Works Department at 412-343-3403. To save refrigerant removal costs, it is suggested that residents have the company delivering the new appliance dispose of the old appliance.

Bring electronic devices for recycling (sponsored by JVS Environmental – www.jvsenvironmental.net) and confidential papers for shredding (provided by Iron Mountain - www.ironmountain.com) to the public works yard at 1250 Lindendale Drive (off Cedar Blvd) from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on the Saturdays listed.

Woody Waste Curbside Pickup – Reservation is required. Please call 412-343-3403, between Monday and no later than 4:30 p.m. on the Thursday the week of pickup. Materials that will be collected are limited to shrubs, tree branches and limbs (no leaves in bags). Please have your materials placed at the curb (not in the street) before 7 a.m. on the pickup day. When preparing your material for pickup, please follow these guidelines:

- ✦ All dirt and debris should be removed from the roots of shrubs. Soil, rocks, leaves, grass clippings and ornamental grasses will not be picked up.
- ✦ Small branches should be gathered into piles (not bound) not exceeding 24 inches in diameter and 48 inches in length.
- ✦ Large tree limbs should be no longer than 6 feet in length and no thicker than 5 inches in diameter.
- ✦ The total amount put out for any one pickup should not exceed more than can be placed into a single pickup truck.

If the above guidelines are not followed, then the materials will be deemed uncollectable and left at the curb.

Yard Waste Recycling Drop-Off - Mt. Lebanon's yard waste drop-off recycling program, available for Mt. Lebanon residents, is on the first Saturday of the month, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3 p.m., from April through the first Saturday in October. Drop off your yard waste at the golf course maintenance facility on Pine Avenue. Leaves and garden residues in recyclable Kraft bags, small twigs, shrubs, brush and branches (under 3 feet) are accepted. NO GRASS CLIPPINGS, STONES, SOIL, STUMPS, LARGE LIMBS OR PLASTIC BAGS ACCEPTED.
