

# MT. LEBANON TRAFFIC BOARD

Meeting Date: January 5 2022

Mr. Waine opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1: Roll Call, Ms. Cole, Mr. Glock, Mr. Sloan, Mr. Waine, Ms. Krieger, and Mr. Whitehead were present. Ms. Green was absent.

Agenda Item 2: Opening Remarks from the Chair

Agenda Item 3: Meeting Notes from December 1, 2021. Mr. Sloan made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 1, 2021 meeting. Ms. Cole seconded the motion and was passed unanimously.

## **Old Business:**

Agenda Item 4: Request for Traffic Calming on Morrison Drive.

Mr. Haberman, Gateway Engineers stated that the next step in the Traffic Calming process is to schedule a Neighborhood meeting to determine a study area. He stated the meeting date will be determined by the municipality and letters will be sent to residents in the 400 block of Morrison Drive inviting them to the meeting. The meeting should be held sometime the beginning of February. Commissioner Silverman requested that an invitation the Neighborhood meeting be sent to Commissioner Ranney. Mr. Haberman advised Commissioner Ranney along with Commissioner Silverman will be invited to the meeting. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 5: Request for Traffic Easement on Cedar Blvd. Between Morgan Drive and Bird Park.

A resident of 1200 block of Cedar Blvd. presented this request at the December meeting and was advised of the Traffic Calming process. No one was present to discuss this item. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 6: Request for One Way Street/Do Not Enter Signage on Crescent Drive.

Mr. Haberman stated that Gateway Engineers reviewed the existing signage at the intersection of Beadling Road and Crescent Drive. The existing signage does advise that Crescent is a One Way street but he recommended adding a "Do Not Enter" sign to the "One Way" sign on the southwest corner. He also recommended that the vegetation on the southeast corner be cut back and "Horizontal Right-One Way" sign by posted. Mr. Glock asked if people who are parking on Crescent during busy times at Beadling Park were turning around and going the wrong way. Lt. Green stated the complaint was only regarding turns off of Beadling Road. A motion was made to recommend approval of the installation of signage as recommended by Gateway Engineers at the intersection of Crescent Drive and Beadling Road. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

## **New Business:**

Agenda Item 8: Request to Make Greenhurst One Lane in Each Direction at Intersection with Lakemont.

Mr. Matthew Clark, spoke regarding an article that was previously published in the Mt. Lebanon Magazine regarding the crash data at this intersection. He stated that the reason for his request is to eliminate the western side of Greenhurst and make the eastern side 2 ways is to make the intersection safer.

Mr. Haberman reported that a study was done at the intersection in 2008 and was presented to Commission but no action was taken on the recommendations. Mr. Haberman stated he will look further into why Commission did not move forward on the recommendation. Ms. Krieger made a motion for

Gateway Engineers to conduct a study at the intersection of Greenhurst Road and Bower Hill Road. Ms. Cole seconded the motion and passed unanimously.
