**Rules for Private Rental**

1. Follow the lifeguards' instruction at all times.
  2. Regular pool rules apply at all times; exceptions must be cleared through the Recreation Center Manager or Pool Supervisor.
  3. No smoking or alcoholic beverages. This includes all areas inside the bath house & pool area.
  4. Food and drinks are restricted to the snack bar area.
  5. No glass containers may be brought within the pool area.
  6. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved floatation devices permitted. Children wearing floatation devices must be in the water within an adult's arm's reach of child.
  7. All posted water slide, AquaClimb, and diving board safety regulations will apply.
  8. Bath houses are for changing. Parties, games, etc., are not permitted. Valuables should be locked in bath house lockers. The Swim Center is not responsible for stolen articles that are left unattended.
  9. Radios, stereo, etc., must have volume turned down to Swim Center's specifications. All sound will be turned off at 9:30p.m.
  10. Radios, stereos, etc., are not permitted to be played in the bath houses.
  11. Chewing gum is prohibited in all areas of the facility.
  12. Proper swimming attire must be worn. Rivets/zippers/buttons are not permitted on slides.
  13. Leak-proof swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained.
  14. Persons with infections or diseases that may be transmitted by the pool water are prohibited (28 Pa. Code 18.53).
  15. Bicycles are not permitted in the pool bath house or on the deck area.
  16. No pets or animals (except service animals for persons with disabilities).
  17. Swimmers cannot leave and reenter the pool area during the pool party.
  18. Motorized vehicles may not be parked on sidewalk except for deliveries of special equipment. Delivery vehicles must be parked in lot during rental.
- Cancellations must be made 72 hours in advance. Cancellations due to inclement weather may be made up until the rental time by either the renter or the swim center.
  - The renter must remove all debris from the pool area at the conclusion of the rental time.
  - Renter is responsible for restoration of any vandalism that may occur to the Swim Center during the renter's time.
  - Violations may result in the early termination of the rental. Management reserves the right to amend the above rules or implement new rules or policies as deemed necessary.
