Woody Waste Curbside Pickup — Materials collected are limited to shrubs, tree branches, and limbs. This is not a pickup for trees you have professionally removed. Please place materials at the curb (not in the street) before 7 a.m. on pickup day. You **must** register for each collection event by calling 412-343-3403 or by using <https://mylebo.mtlebanon.org/>, by Thursday, 4:30 p.m. the week of that collection event. When preparing your material for pickup, please follow these guidelines:

- Please remove all dirt and debris from roots of shrubs. We will not pick up soil or rocks.
- Place small branches into piles (**not bound**) not exceeding 24 inches in diameter and 48 inches in length.
- Large tree limbs should be a maximum of 6 feet in length and 5 inches in diameter.
- Total amount put out for any one pickup cannot exceed the amount that fits in a single pickup truck (4' x 4' x 8').

We are unable to collect material if you do not follow these guidelines.

Yard Waste Recycling Drop-Off — Mt. Lebanon's yard waste drop-off recycling program, available to Mt. Lebanon residents, is on the first Saturday of the month, from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., from April through the first Saturday in October. Drop off yard waste at the golf course maintenance facility, Pine Avenue. We accept leaves and garden residues in recyclable leaf bags, small twigs, shrubs, brush, and branches (under 3 feet.) **No grass clippings, stones, soil, stumps, large limbs, or plastic bags.**

Dear Mt. Lebanon Resident:

Mt. Lebanon Municipality provides a comprehensive solid waste program designed to encourage recycling and waste reduction, reduce litter in our neighborhoods and ensure that waste is disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner. This guide includes various services that are available to residents. Waste Management pledges to provide the high-quality service residents expect and deserve.

Regular Curbside Collection

Waste Management will continue waste and recycling collection in Mt. Lebanon through 2023. Garbage and refuse will be collected once every week according to the attached street listing. Recycling will be collected every other week; please see the calendar and street listing to identify your collection day. Place material at the curb after 6 p.m. on the prior day or **before 6 a.m.** on the scheduled collection day.

Service Inquiries

Residents should direct all questions and complaints regarding refuse and recycling collection to Mt. Lebanon at **412-343-3400**. In the event of inclement weather, visit www.wm.com/alerts for service updates, delays and cancellations.

General Guidelines

- Garbage should be properly secured in containers (40 gallons or less) or plastic bags, weighing 50 pounds or less. Place garbage at curbside, in one area, and do not exceed 15 bags/cans and 2 bulk items per week.
- Grass clippings and weeds should be in plastic bags.
- Furniture items, appliances, household goods and disassembled children's swing sets (cut to 4-foot length) will be accepted at curbside.
- Carpet should be rolled and tied in lengths not to exceed 48 inches so that one person can lift.
- Empty paint cans and dried paint are acceptable. Paint can be dried by air drying or soaking up with newspaper or kitty litter. Lids should be off.

Special Backyard Service Fee

Waste Management can furnish backyard collection service limited to four cans of general household refuse plus one recycling container. Grass clippings, furniture and appliances, will be picked up at the curb only. Residents may request this service directly by contacting Waste Management at **800-866-4460**. The monthly fee is \$29.37 for garbage, \$11.44 for recycle or \$40.81 for both.

Mt. Lebanon Special Recycling Days

Bring electronic devices for recycling and confidential papers for shredding to the public works yard at 1250 Lindendale Drive (off Cedar Blvd.) from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on the Saturdays listed on the calendar. Valid for Mt. Lebanon residents only. Only one (1) free TV per car. There will be a \$25 fee for appliances containing refrigerant and a \$2 fee for every mercury bulb. **Shredding fee will be \$8/box: cash or checks only.**

Excluded Items

Building material may be picked up for a fee by contacting Waste Management at **800-866-4460**.

- Hazardous Household Waste (including paint, thinners, cleaners, pesticides/ herbicides, etc.) - see PA Resources Council website for events (www.prc.org).
- Automobile parts including wheel rims and tires.
- Trees, branches and bushes (see Woody Waste Collection Days on calendar).
- Ashes from furnaces and fireplaces. Stones and dirt.
- Leaves (municipality provides leaf pickup - see fall Mt. Lebanon Magazine).
- Electronics per Municipal Ordinance 3184 (see recycling calendar for drop-off events).
- Appliances containing refrigerant. Items such as refrigerators, air conditioners, etc. will be collected ONLY if the item has a sticker certifying the refrigerant has been removed. For a list of companies that supply stickers and remove refrigerant, please call the Public Works Department at **412-343-3403**.

2023 Recycling Program

We are excited to announce the acceptance of plastic tubs in your curbside recycling program. Acceptable plastic tubs have a snap on lid and hold food such as yogurt, cottage cheese, cream cheese, and butter. Plastic tub lids and food must be removed before the container can be recycled.

Waste Management is asking your community to help combat recycling contamination. For programs to be successful, all participants must make an effort to practice good recycling habits

- No plastic bags of any kind will be accepted. Please place material loose in your recycling bin or cart.
- Make sure you are only recycling plastic bottles, jugs, jars and tubs. Any other plastic shape must go in the trash.
- Glass is no longer accepted for curbside recycling - Recycle bins are available at the Kohls Parking Lot at Village Square.
- Containers that held food should be rinsed free of food debris and liquid.
- Shredded paper is not accepted.

Recycling will be collected every-other-week. Place only the acceptable recyclables shown below together in your recycling cart or bin.
