AN ORDINANCE OF MT. LEBANON, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING
THE MUNICIPALITY'S ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO INCREASE
THE SIZE OF THE COMMUNITY RELATIONS BOARD

Introduction

The Municipality's Commission (the "Commission") finds that the Municipality's Community Relations Board requires additional members with particular skills which contribute to the Board's accomplishment of its purpose.

Therefore, Mt. Lebanon, Pennsylvania ordains as follows (new language is underlined and deleted language is in brackets):

Section 1. Chapter 1 (Administration and Government), Part 1 (Administrative Code) of the Municipality's Codified Ordinances, Section 128.2, is hereby amended to increase the size of the Community Relations Board as follows:

128.2 Membership and Term. [The Community Relations Board shall consist of five (5) members appointed by ward for a three (3) year term.] The Community Relations Board shall consist of not fewer than five, nor more than seven, members, each appointed for a three (3) year term. Five (5) members shall be appointed by ward and two (2) members shall be appointed at large. The terms of not more than two (2) members shall expire during any year.
