101.2 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

All law enforcement Chief Executive Officers employed within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania are required to meet specific requirements for appointment. This policy provides guidelines for the appointment of the Chief Executive Officer of the Mt. Lebanon Police Department, who is required to exercise the powers and duties of the office as prescribed by state law (8 Pa.C.S. § 1121; 42 Pa.C.S. § 2921; 71 P.S. § 646; 53 P.S. § 66905).

101.3 POLICY

It is the policy of the Mt. Lebanon Police Department that the Chief of Police meets the minimum standards for exercising his/her authority granted by law.

101.4 CHIEF OF POLICE REQUIREMENTS

The Chief of Police of this department, as a condition of continued employment, shall be certified by the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (53 Pa.C.S. § 2167).
