

MT. LEBANON POLICE DEPARTMENT CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. Class members must be at least 18 years of age. Preference will be given to residents, business owners or those employed within the Municipality of Mt. Lebanon. Acceptance of applicants not fitting in one of the above residency categories is at the discretion of the Mt. Lebanon Police Department.
- All applicants will be subject to a criminal history check as a precondition to acceptance into the Academy. Deadline for return of application is Friday, August 18, 2023. Return applications in person to the Police Department front desk, or mail to Mt. Lebanon Police Department, Community Outreach Unit, 555 Washington Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15228.
- 3. The Chief of Police has final approval of all applications and reserves the right to deny entry to any applicant. Accepted applicants will be notified by phone or email.
- 4. The Academy is free of charge to all members. Class size is limited.
- 5. Dress for class is casual. Uniform shirts will be provided to attendees, to be worn to class.
- 6. Qualified applicants who are denied admission due to class size constraints will be given preference when the next Academy session is scheduled. Applicants are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.
- 7. The Release of Liability form (attached) must be signed and returned by the applicant with each completed application.
- 8. Classes will be held at the Mt. Lebanon Public Safety Building, 2nd Floor Learning Center. Classes will start on Tuesday, September 05, 2023 and conclude on Tuesday, November 14, 2023. Classes will be held from 6:30 P.M. to 9:30 P.M.
- 9. There will be no class session on Tuesday, October 31st. Class will resume the following week.
- 10. Please contact the Mt. Lebanon Police Department at 412-343-4068 or 412-343-4069 with any questions.
- 11. Ride-a-longs with MLPD must be scheduled on student's own time and applied for separately. Students will receive more information at the first class session.
- 12. Attendees who miss more than 2 nights of classes will not be allowed to return.
- 13. Attendees who disrupt class will be asked to leave and will not be allowed to return.
- 14. Attendees agree to allow their photographic images to be used for promotional purposes.
