ABOUT THE CITIZENS FIRE ACADEMY

The Mt. Lebanon Fire Department has created an 8-week public education class to provide residents and business owners with a free opportunity to learn how the department operates.

Firefighters teach every class, covering topics such as engine and truck company operations, rescue techniques, fire extinguishers, fire prevention, public education, and emergency medical services.

Participants leave the academy with a real feel for the job thanks to hands-on demonstrations and opportunities to accompany firefighters on actual fire calls.
