These are the most fundamental beliefs by which the organization operates. The values established by this organization are nonnegotiable, teachable, and are constantly on display before our employees and the community. They guide and inspire us in all we say and do. Our guiding principles toward the attainment of our mission/vision are:

- (a) Integrity honesty and consistent uprightness of character; demonstrating and understanding what is right; holding true to and standing firm on values, principles and convictions; accepting accountability, acting reliably and responsibility; providing positive role models for our community; included within integrity is Trustworthiness, Ethical Behavior, and Fairness.
