## **Old Business:**

Agenda Item 4: Change the No Parking Signage (Ordinance) in front of Mekka on Washington Road to Coincide with rush hour traffic Monday through Friday.

Mr. Haberman has investigated this Item. The current signage is from 6AM-10AM, rush hour typically ends around 9AM. Other signage in the area is from 6AM-9AM, Mr. Haberman stated it only makes sense to keep it consistent. A motion was made to change the signage from 6AM-10AM to 6AM-9AM.

## **New Business:**

Agenda Item 5: Timer Extension on Crosswalk at Intersection of Washington Road and Mayfair Drive  
Patrick Burns 145 Seneca

Mr. Haberman stated that there is an existing extra 3 seconds of time already in place for pedestrians to cross. This is consistent with the rest of the crosswalks on Washington Road.

Agenda Item 5: Speed humps, painting crosswalk on lower portion by Old Hickory, flashing crosswalk lights, narrow the travel lanes, and remove double yellow lines on Scrubgrass. – Stephen Antonelli 780 Scrubgrass

Many people in the neighborhood came to speak about this regarding speeding and accidents. Mr. Haberman stated that he would look into trying to get speed data. He also suggested that he could meet with residents of the neighborhood to discuss possible options or solutions to this problem. He did inform them that they could create a petition and follow the petition process.

Nicole Parker 365 Orchard Drive spoke regarding improving signage regarding the crosswalk at the intersection of Orchard Drive and Mt Lebanon Boulevard. Neighbors in the neighborhood also agreed that visibility is low, and signage should be improved.
