TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION GUIDE 2024

Dear Mt. Lebanon Resident,

We are pleased to inform you that County Hauling, a Noble Environmental company, was awarded the contract for residential trash and recycling collection in Mt. Lebanon beginning January 1, 2024. We look forward to providing Mt. Lebanon with a safe and efficient collection program! Our goal is to keep as many collection days the same as possible, however there are a few streets that will be receiving service for trash and recycling on different days. Please see the attached street listings to determine your regularly scheduled pick-up day. Please keep in mind that New Year's Day falls on a Monday this year so the first collection of the year **will be delayed by one day**.

The following guidelines apply to all residential trash and recycling collection in the Municipality:

- Trash and recycling must be out after 6 PM the night before your collection day, or prior to 6 AM on the day of collection.
- Recycling will begin on the week of January 8 and will be collected **every other week** moving forward for all residences.
- All trash and recycling containers, as well as bulk items, must be within five feet of the curb (or five feet from the edge of a traveled road) and placed so as not to interfere with the collection of other items, block the right of way or obstruct traffic. Items not visible or otherwise obstructed from view will not be collected.
- All **trash MUST be bagged** before being placed in a trash can; bags/cans should not weigh more than 50 lbs. Loose trash is a potential health hazard for our employees, is more difficult to collect and is a major factor in municipal litter. There will be a weekly limit of fifteen (15) bags of trash, and one (1) bulk item – including but not limited to: furniture, appliances, household goods – per house. Carpet/rugs should be rolled, tied or duct taped, and no longer than four (4) feet.
- Empty and dried paint cans are acceptable, but may not be in bags, and must have the lids off. To dry excess paint, fill can with newspaper, kitty litter, or paint hardener.
- Excluded items include but are not limited to hazardous household waste, automobile parts including tires, tree debris including leaves, and ashes. Please see www.mtlebanon.org.
- There will be a limit of one (1) bulk item per week for each household.
- See the attached calendar for the holiday collection schedule. If a holiday falls on a weekday, collection is pushed back one day for all days that follow.



Special Backyard Service Fee

County Hauling can furnish backyard collection services for regular household refuse and recycling. Bulk items must be picked up at the curb. Residents may request this service by contacting County Hauling at 724-929-7694. The monthly fee for this service is \$40 for garbage, \$35 for recycling, or \$75 for both.


All **recycling MUST BE LOOSE** in the containers. If you are placing loose cardboard out for recycling, please flatten all boxes and stack them neatly next to your recycling can. There will be no limit on the amount of recycling collected each week. Each recycling container must have at least one (1) green MT LEBANON RECYCLING sticker on it. These are available at the municipal building, 710 Washington Road, and the library, 16 Castle Shannon Boulevard, or you may call 412-343-3400.

Glass is back!! Clear, brown, blue, and green glass food and beverage containers or jars will be accepted in your recycling containers.

Types 3-7 Plastics are no longer recyclable. There is no market for this material, so please dispose in trash. If it ends up in the recycling, it will be trucked to the recycling plant, then sorted and trucked to the landfill. The best way to reduce the carbon footprint of each item is to follow these guidelines closely and be sure to reach out to our Customer Service if you have any questions!

The two types of plastic that are still recyclable are **Types 1 & 2**, which are among the most common. Examples of Type 1 include soda, water, salad dressing and cooking oil bottles, (either bottles you drink from, or that hold consumables). Some examples of Type 2 include milk and juice jugs, shampoo, conditioner or bodywash bottles, and laundry detergent containers. Neither of these lists are comprehensive, so be sure to check each container for the recycling logo and the codes PET or PETE for Type 1, and PEHD or HDPE for Type 2. If the container has any of these codes, it is recyclable. If it does not, then it is not recyclable.

Household Hazardous Waste Events — The municipality will host three hazardous waste recycling collection events on **April 6, June 8, and August 10**, from 9 A.M. to 1 P.M. by our contractor, Noble Environmental. You **MUST** pre-register at **www.NobleEnviro.com** for the events to minimize wait times and ensure your safety. Rates vary for different materials and are listed on our website. **Only credit card payments will be accepted.** If you cannot participate in these events, contact **www.prc.org** for other events and information.

Woody Waste Curbside Pickup — Materials collected are limited to shrubs, tree branches and limbs. This is not a pickup for trees you have professionally removed. Please place materials at the curb (not in the street) before 7 A.M. on pickup day. You **must** register for each collection event by calling 412-343-3403 or by using **mylebo.mtlebanon.org** by Thursday, 4:30 P.M., the week of that collection event. When preparing your material for pickup, please follow these guidelines:

- Please remove all dirt and debris from roots of shrubs. We will not pick up soil or rocks.
- Place small branches into piles (**not bound**) not exceeding 24 inches in diameter and 48 inches in length.
- Large tree limbs should be a maximum of 6 feet in length and 5 inches in diameter.
- Total amount put out for any one pickup cannot exceed the amount that fits in a single pickup truck (4' x 4' x 8').

We are unable to collect material if you do not follow these guidelines.

Yard Waste Recycling Drop-Off — Mt. Lebanon's yard waste drop-off recycling program, available to Mt. Lebanon residents, is on the first Saturday of the month, from 7 A.M. to 3 P.M., from April through the first Saturday in October. Drop off yard waste at the golf course maintenance facility, Pine Avenue. We accept leaves and garden residues in recyclable leaf bags, small twigs, shrubs, brush, and branches (under 3 feet.) **No grass clippings, stones, soil, stumps, large limbs, or plastic bags.**
