1. Meeting Minutes

- a. Active Transportation Plan
Mr. Davis encouraged everyone to view the Commission discussion session on this subject. Mr. Davis moved and Ms Babb seconded to request the mobility board have the chance to review and comment on the Active Transportation Plan before the plan is finalized by the Commission. The motion carried unanimously.
- b. Pedestrian Safety Projects
Chief Haberman talked about pedestrian safety and gave history regarding the safe walking route program, school guard positions, school drop-off zones, traffic patterns around schools, implementing the Paul Miller law, crash data, and grants. There was further discussion regarding pedestrian traffic.
- c. Castle Shannon Boulevard
Ms McCabe talked about applying to PennDOT to request Castle Shannon Boulevard be transferred back to municipal ownership and the opportunities that could open.

David Helwig, 16 Rocklynn Place, would like to see a few more crosswalks on Mt. Lebanon Boulevard. He is pleased to see more police presence in the municipality and would like to see more enforcement of traffic laws.
