Allegheny County is required to update its Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) every five years. The most recent update was completed in 2025 and must be formally adopted by each participating municipality in 2026. The plan was developed through a collaborative effort involving Allegheny County, its municipalities, and a third-party consultant. Its purpose is to serve as a pre-disaster, multi-hazard mitigation plan to guide the County and its municipalities toward increased resilience to disasters.

The Allegheny County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA). Adoption of the plan is necessary for the County and its municipalities to remain eligible for federal and state hazard mitigation funding and technical assistance programs.

The plan is a living document that will be updated and maintained to address natural and human-made hazards that pose significant risk to Allegheny County and its municipalities. Adoption of this plan is required to receive post-disaster program funds.

WHEREAS, Mt. Lebanon, Pennsylvania Allegheny County, Pennsylvania (“Mt. Lebanon”) is most vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, Mt. Lebanon acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

WHEREAS, the Allegheny County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Allegheny County Emergency Management Agency and the Allegheny County Planning Commission in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of Mt. Lebanon, and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Allegheny County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Allegheny County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-made hazards that face the County and its municipal governments,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mt. Lebanon Commission:

- The Allegheny County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of Mt. Lebanon, and
- The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Allegheny County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.
